COMMUNIQUÉ

In exercise of the powers vested in him under section 60(4)(a) of the Constitution, and acting in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, His Excellency Mr Prithvirajsing ROOPUN, G.C.S.K, the President of the Republic, has revoked the appointment of the Hon. Ivan Leslie COLLENDAVELLOO, G.C.S.K., SC, as Deputy Prime Minister, Minister of Energy and Public Utilities, with immediate effect.
