Introduction

This poetry competition bears the illustrious name of the late Edouard Maunick - poet, diplomat, critic and one of Mauritius's most extraordinary literary voices, who embodied resilience, creativity, and intellectual brilliance.

From “*Ces oiseaux de sang*” to “*Ki Koté La Mer?*”, his writings brought the world’s attention to our island, giving voice to our beautiful, complex and unique Mauritian identity, while also speaking to our universal human experiences.

It is therefore fitting that his remarkable talent was recognised with prestigious awards, including the *Prix Guillaume Apollinaire* in 1977 and the *Grand Prix de la Francophonie* from the French Academy in 2003.

I commend Mr. Rama Poonoosamy for initiating this poetry competition and for sustaining it over the years, so that the legacy of Edouard Maunick can inspire new generations of Mauritian writers.

I also wish to honour the members of the jury, Shenaz Patel and Kavinien Karupudayyan, for their invaluable contribution.

I extend my heartfelt congratulations in particular to the distinguished Ananda Devi, one of our foremost contemporary literary voices.

Her remarkable body of work has earned her numerous accolades, including the 2024 Neustadt Prize, the 2023 Prix de la langue française, and this year's Prix Gide du Contemporain Capital.

Her recent achievement has brought Mauritius once again to the forefront of the international literary stage, demonstrating the richness of our island's creative talent.

Writers and Creators

Since 2016, this competition has been a wonderful way to celebrate the creativity of our writers and poets.

I commend the *Recueil de Poèmes Primés* — a laudable effort by Immedia that has preserved these works and ensured that they continue to inspire future generations.

This year's theme, “*Rhythmes*”, drew 136 participants and 307 poems in French, English, and Mauritian Creole - a true reflection of the richness and diversity of our literary talent.

I congratulate all participants and wish them good luck in their literary journey ahead.

Way Forward: Reflections

Dear Friends,

This evening's gathering must also be an invitation for reflection.

Allow me to share a few thoughts on the broader role of literature and poetry in our society.

We are living at a time when artificial intelligence is advancing rapidly and reading habits are on the decline, both in Mauritius and globally.

As President of the Republic, my main mission is nation-building, which requires the participation of all.

How do we come together as a nation, if not through stories, words, shared experiences and the power of imagination that allows us to explore, reflect, and connect?

In this context, the role of our creators, writers and poets takes on even greater significance in fostering a culture of readership and helping people, especially the younger generations, rediscover a love for poetry, the arts, and books – both online and offline.

Our nation can also benefit from a *répertoire des écrivains*: a consolidated platform where the voices of our literary talents can be preserved.

By embracing French, English, and Kreol Morisien, the *Prix de Poésie Édouard Maunick* beautifully mirrors our linguistic and cultural plurality.

Yet, Mauritius is a rainbow nation. Looking ahead, one may ask—why stop at just three languages?

By embracing all the languages spoken by our citizens, this competition could become a truly multi-cultural, multi-lingual, inclusive *projet républicain*, celebrating the full richness and diversity of our island's cultural and linguistic heritage.
